Fall Assignment—Midterm and Final Assignment: Peer Review

Assignment: Composing a Convincing Argument

Reference: Introduction to Pregnancy Counseling by Paula Vandegaer, L.C.S.W.

As scholars (and almost post baccalaureate professionals), you should be able to apply and synthesize what you've learned. So, here is your mid-term assignment: Compose a convincing argument for the Morning After Pill, the Abortion Pill, Abortion Reversal Pill.

Most women coming into the pregnancy center contemplating abortion are between 6-8 weeks pregnant. This means they are eligible for the morning after pill (Plan B) and/or the abortion pill (RU-486) known as Plan C. For some reason, women believe that this form of birth control is safer. What could we say to them in order to protect the woman from unforeseen consequences and to save the life of her pre-born child? We lose a lot of babies to the morning after and RU-486 pills. How do we advocate? Where does the Abortion Reversal Pill come into play? How can DCPC navigate a better option/an abortion alternative for our clients?

Your convincing argument should:

- Consider the reasons why a woman would consider either pill to be the safe option.
- Explain the unforeseen consequences in a way that expresses care and concern for the potential mother.
- Boldly and with valid points speak up for the life of the unborn.
- Offer the potential mother a better alternative and practical help.

Assignment: Presenting Clients

Reference: Pro-life Apologetics Course

Presentation Date: During the April Volunteer Training Meeting

Prior to presentation

Submit 2 'Request to Present Client' forms to the Executive Director for approval

Date of presentation

Introduce the client using 4 standard identifies:

- Gender, Age
- Number of Children, Educational Level, and Employment Status
- Likely to carry/Likely to Abort, Pregnancy Test read negative
- Willingness to attend program

Presentation Topics:

- Where was the client when he/she started the Parenting Education Program?
- How far has he/she come along?
- How has God moved in his/her life?
- What is next for him/her? How are you going to help him/her get there?

Solicit Peer Feedback

- Ask 2-3 questions requesting support from your peers.



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Spring Assignment—Written Report

Assignment: Written summary of the experience with an overview of how the job fits into the health care industry.

Your report should:

1. Identify how the organization fits into sector of health care system
2. Identify how the sector fits into the entire health care system
3. Explain the economic environments
4. Explain the policy/regulatory/legal environment
5. Identify economic incentives facing the organization
6. Describe the policy/legal constraints facing the organization
7. Analyze the ways the incentives and constraints affect the operations of the organization

Report submission should include 'show and tell' documents like forms, newsletters, etc. indicating assignments and projects completed during internship. Keep in mind that there are issues with privacy and possibly with proprietary information. Please get clearance with your supervisor before including documents.
